

# DOMAINE DU CARROU

## Technical description

### SANCERRE ROSE "Domaine du Carrou"

**Description** : The particular situation and orientation of the plot, nestled on a steep hill at the very top of the village, coupled with a control of the yields deliver a rosé full of fruit and freshness.

**Soil type** : Hard Portlandian clay subsoil is overlaid by a clay-limestone surface and brown clacimorphic soils. This particular geological combination gives the wine its well-marked aromas of white fruits (peach) and berries (currants).

**Grape variety** : Pinot noir

**Average age of the vines** : 30 years

**Location of the vineyard** : Bué

**Orientation** : east to north-east

**Elevation** : 350 meters

**Area** : 1.2 hectares (3 acres)

**Winemaking** :

- immediate pressing
- fermentation at controlled temperature
- ageing in stainless steel vats for 5 months
- Bottling at the end of February

**Yield** : 50 hl/hectare

**Production** : 8,000 bottles

**Accompaniment** : a summer wine par excellence, it can be drunk at any time of the day and goes perfectly with charcuterie, grilled meat (plancha and barbecue), pizza, and Asian cuisine. Or in winter try coupling it with smoked fish or smoked charcuterie.
