Technical description

SANCERRE WHITE "Les Déserts"

<u>Description</u>: Steep sun-drenched vineyard, located on an ideally exposed hillside overlooking the valley in which nestles the village of Bué.

Soil type:

100% "Terres blanches" – clay-limestone from the late Jurassic lower Kimmeridgian (135-140 million years old) – These clay-limestones bring opulence and richness to the wine, **counterbalanced by a delicate saline tension on the finish.**

Grape variety: Sauvignon blanc

Average age of the vines: 40 years

Location of the vineyard: Bué

Orientation: from south-east to south-west

Elevation: 300 meters

Area: a select 30 ares (0.75 acres) in a plot of 1 hectare (2.5 acres)

Winemaking:

- immediate pressing
- fermentation at controlled temperature
- ageing on fine lees for 10 months, with 20% in barrels and 80% in stainless steel vats.
- blending in summer and bottling one year after harvesting

Yield: 55 hl/hectare

Production: 2,000 bottles

<u>Accompaniment</u>: Les Déserts is the perfect partner for scallops, river and saltwater fish, as well as white meats, and in particular veal sweetbreads served with morels in a cream sauce.
